Arrival	Coaches / Parents / Players	Follow Social Distancing recommendations at all times. When arriving, ensure that the one-way system from the car park to the field is followed. Sanitize hands on arrival. Avoid gathering in groups or clusters in the car parking area.	All users	Do not arrive more than 10 minutes before the start time of the course - arrivals from 9:20am	10-15 minutes
Indoor Areas	Coaches / Players	Indoor areas will be significantly restricted, especially in good weather, with the course and any break time taking place outdoors. In adverse weather where inside areas are needed, social distancing measures will be in place with clear guidance given to players on areas they may go to during sessions / break times	Restriction on who enters the building	All day	As required
Toilets	Coaches / Players	Toilet facilities will be available on site – 1 player at a time to use	Control by coaches	As required	n/a
Break Times	Coaches / Players	Allocated spaces will be provided for each player to place their drinks / food / clothing. Spaces will adhere to social-distancing guidelines	Set out by coaches and directions followed by players	Spaces will be allocated to players on arrival	For use all day
Lunch break	Coaches / Players	Players will sit in their team groups in their socially-distanced, allocated spaces for their lunch break	Set out by coaches and directions followed by players	Spaces will be allocated to players on arrival	For use all day
Touching of Equipment - Balls / Cones / Poles	Coaches / Players	Standard equipment will be cleaned before the commencement of activities. Regular cleaning throughout the day as required at the end of each sub-session will be carried out. Players will be asked to sanitize their hands upon collection of equipment	Cleaning by Coaches of equipment	Various stages of the day as required	As needed without delay
Bibs	Coaches / Players	Clean bibs will be allocated to players on arrival so that we are able to determine their teams for the day. These must be worn by the individual throughout the day and not shared	Bibs will be collected by coaches at the end of the day and washed as required	Before / End of the Course	Before next session

First Aid / Injury	Coaches / Players	If a player is deemed to require first aid, this will be conducted following an initial evaluation from the required 2m. If the players injury is superficial or deemed not life threatening, first aid treatment will only be given wearing appropriate PPE. First aid treatment must be given in line with the training received	Ensure first aid kits have additional hand gel, disposable gloves, and face masks	As required	n/a
Departure	Coaches / Parents / Players	Follow the one-way system back to the car park and use hand sanitizers on exit from field. Avoid congregating in groups in the car park.	All users	Collection time at the end of the course - 3:30pm onwards	No more than 10 minutes
